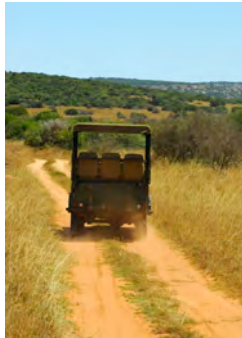

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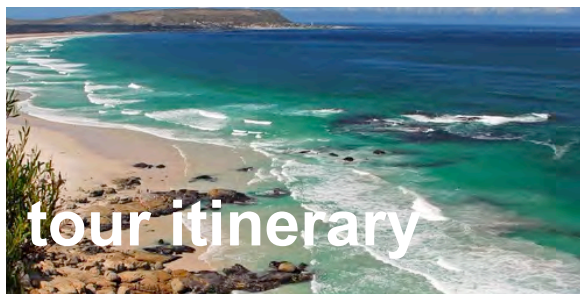

February 5, 2009 Welcome as we visit South Africa a country with a world of treasures. We fly to Washington today and then fly direct on South African Airways to Johannesburg.

February 6, 2009 Our tour begins today in Sandton. Get to meet your fellow passengers this evening at our gala welcome dinner. (D)

February 7, 2009 Today you will be immersed in the culture of South Africa during a guided tour of Soweto township. View luxurious mansions and informal settlements as you learn about the historic significance of the area. Experience the regional lifestyle as you join locals for an included lunch at a nearby Shebeen (tavern). This afternoon visit the Apartheid Museum.(B,L)

February 8, 2009 Today we take the panoramic route as we travel through the breathtaking Drakensburg Mountain Range en route to Kruger National Park. The scenery is sure to astound you as we pass through the Blyde River Canyon. Later we'll arrive at our hotel situated on the banks of the Sabi River. (B,D)

February 9, 2009 Today will be unforgettable and a definite highlight of this journey as we visit Kruger National Park for our Safari Game Drive. Don't forget your cameras! Our day begins with an open air vehicle safari game drive lead by a local expert who leads us in search of the Big 5 – elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard and rhino. Watch carefully as you may also see a graceful impala, dazzling zebra or gorgeous giraffe. Return in time for an afternoon at leisure to relax by the pool, enjoy a round of golf or view playful hippos in the nearby river! This evening enjoy an authentic African experience at Shangana Village. Tribal customs and tradition come to life in this evening full of ceremonies, entertainment and dinner. (B,D)

February 10, 2009 Today we travel back to Johannesburg and board a flight to Port Elizabeth. beautiful Garden Route. (B)



February 11, 2009 We start the day by traveling through the unspoiled Tsitsikamma Forest and along the southern coast taking in South Africa's spectacular Garden Route. Enjoy the jagged coastline and quaint villages along the way. We eventually will arrive in the picturesque resort town of Knysna, in the heart of the Garden Route, where we will spend the next two nights. (B)

February 12, 2009 We explore this beautiful area with a visit to nearby Featherbed Nature Reserve. The adventure begins with a lagoon cruise out to the famous Knysa Heads. We then board a 4x4 vehicle and travel deep into the forest. We'll discover the beautiful flora and fauna during a leisurely-paced nature walk. Lunch is provided amongst the milkwood trees before our return cruise. Enjoy some time this afternoon to explore Knysna's charming waterfront before a delightful dinner overlooking the lagoon. (B,L,D)

February 13, 2009 Travel to Oudtshoorn, the ostrich capital of South Africa. We'll enjoy a guided tour of one of the oldest working ostrich farms in the area and, if you wish, go for a ride on one of these great birds. After a BBQ lunch we travel through the changing landscapes to Cape Town where we are staying in one the top rated hotels in the World – the Sheraton Cape Town. Dinner is also included this evening. (B,L,D)

February 14, 2009 Cape Town - what a romantic spot to enjoy Valentines Day! We enjoy a panoramic tour of the city and enjoy a thrilling ride on a cable car up over 3000 feet, landing atop Table Mountain. The views will leave your breathless. The remainder of the day is at leisure to discover charming Victoria and Alfred Waterfront. (B)

February 15, 2009 Today we explore the coastal scenery and charming towns that populate the Cape Peninsula. At Cape Point we visit the penguins at Boulder Beach. On our return we visit famous Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens home to over 5,000 species of plants native to South Africa. (B)



February 15, 2009 This morning is yours to independently explore Cape Town. Perhaps you'll want to visit historic Robben Island and the prison where Nelson Mandela spent many years. This afternoon travel the winelands and uncover the enchanted beauty of its mountainous landscapes and endless vineyards. Enjoy a South African winemaking cellar tour and tasting at one of the area's oldest estate wineries. Tonight we gather for our gala farewell dinner. (B,D)

February 16, 2009 After breakfast we head for the airport. What a once in a lifetime journey we have had!! (B)
