MARCH 13

Cayo Levantado is a small island off the Northeast Coast of the Dominican Republic in Samana Bay. Many people claim the beach here is one of the most beautiful ones in the Caribbean. This port is also a perfect spot to watch for the hundreds of humpbacked whales that venture into this area from January to March.

MARCH 23
