THURSDAY, JULY 7, 2011 Calgary (D)

Meet your fellow passengers this morning at Toronto Airport. Relax aboard a direct flight to Calgary. On arrival in Calgary we will board our coach for a short get your bearings sightseeing tour and then check in to the International Hotel & Suites which is in a prime downtown location. Mingle tonight at our Welcome to Calgary dinner.

FRIDAY, JULY 8, 2011 Calgary (B,D)

Enjoy a hearty breakfast before spending the day at the famous Calgary Stampede. You'll have Grandstand tickets to see the exciting Rodeo this afternoon. The Rodeo is the main event at the Stampede and you'll be thrilled with the show! This world-class rodeo highlights saddle bronco, bareback riding, and thrilling bull riding. Laugh at the crazy clowns, cow milking and wild horse races. Reminisce about your day at dinner this evening.

SATURDAY, JULY 9, 2011 Calgary (B)

After breakfast you'll have some time to explore downtown Calgary or relax at the hotel. This afternoon we will enjoy a tour of Calgary with a local guide and then it is back to the Calgary Stampede. Enjoy some of the excellent food offered at the Stampede before taking your seat for the Stampede Evening Grandstand Show which includes the thrilling chuck wagon races beginning at 8 pm, plus a live musical presentation with top variety acts and the famous Young Canadians. SUNDAY, JULY 10, 2011 Calgary to Banff (B,D)

After breakfast we will depart Calgary for a scenic drive to Canada's Rocky Mountains! Our hotel in Banff is the Brewster's Mountain Lodge and its location is in the heart downtown. Pick up some souvenirs at the shops close by and then freshen up before our delicious dinner at a Banff restaurant.

MONDAY, JULY 11, 2011 Banff Area (B,L,D)

Following a continental breakfast, we'll enjoy a guided tour around Banff and Lake Louise with a highlight stop at Sulphur Mountain where we will take a gondola ride to the top for a fantastic view of the Rockies (2,281m / 7,486 feet above sea level). This spectacular unobstructed 360° panorama of the mountain scenery is the best in Canada. We've included lunch today. This afternoon, you are free to sightsee, shop and enjoy Banff, one of Canada's most treasured towns. Tonight is a fun evening at the "Oh Canada, Eh!" dinner show.

TUESDAY, JULY 12, 2011 Banff Area (B,D)

It's another full day of sightseeing as we travel from Banff to the Columbia Icefields to ride on the thrilling SnoCoach. We will travel in this specially designed vehicle to the middle of the Athabasca Glacier, a five km round trip journey. Our driver will point out interesting geological features as we travel in safety and comfort. At the icefall below the glacier headwall, you will have the option of stepping out onto ice formed as long as 400 years ago. We'll return Banff in time for our Farewell Dinner at a popular local restaurant.

WEDNESDAY, JULY 13, 2011 (B)
