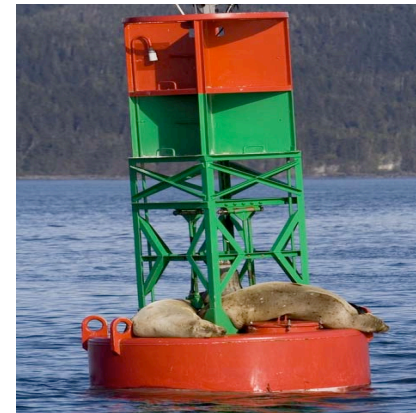

Friday, July 3

Wednesday, July 8

What a wonderful day. We have a morning stop in Juneau. Whale watching is best here and the Mendenhall Glacier is worth a visit. We then depart for Sawyer Glacier. We travel for hours down a breathtaking Fjord and the Sawyer Glacier will greet us with all her beauty. On a sunny day Sawyer glitters and the thrill and noise of big chunks of ice falling from the glacier is something you will never forget!

Thursday, July 9

Most people will want to ride on the White Pass Scenic Railway while we visit Skagway today. The all-you-can-eat Salmon Bakes are also popular here. They coat the Salmon with a brown sugar sauce that is delicious! I can almost taste it now. You'll have time to finish up your souvenir shopping. Surprisingly I find quality souvenirs in Alaska very reasonable.

Friday, July 10

Today you have a relaxing day at sea so enjoy the ship. Maybe attend an information seminar so you can learn more about Alaska. Treat yourself and visit the spa!
